

PALLET SLAT SPACING

We have in our manufacturing process made jigs to ensure that the spacing of the pallet slats are spaced in a way to ensure that the corners of the cartons are always supported.

The spacings of the slats can't be equally spaced as this won't support the cartons as supposed to. The general sizing of cartons is as follows:

- 300mm x 400mm
- 400mm x 500mm
- 400mm x 600mm
- 300mm x 500mm

Please see addendum A for the spacing of the following example pallets:

- 1000mm (top slats) x 1200mm (bearers) pallet – as the citrus- or E-pallet
- 1200mm (top slats) x 1000mm (bearers) pallet – as the 9 slat white block pallet

The spacing of the slats are positioned that the cartons are supported in the middle of the applicable slat at the following points:

- 300mm
- 400mm
- 500mm
- 600mm

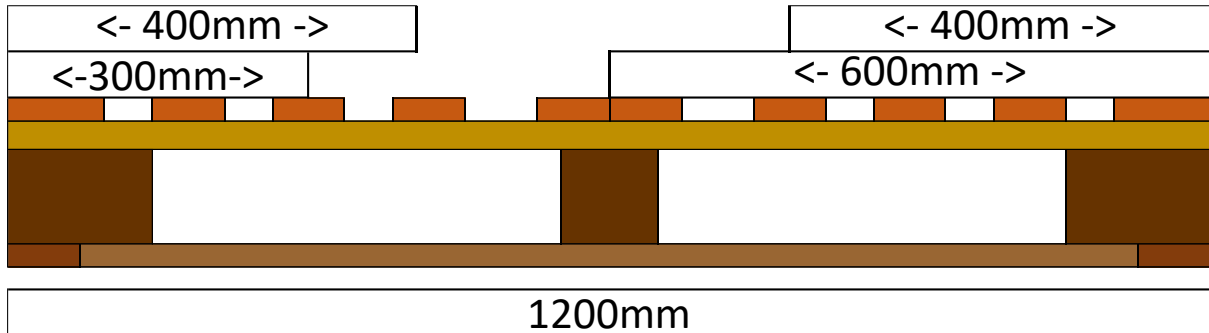
As there are minor deviations to carton sizing for certain markets, there are also various pallets available that conforms to these sizing. The spacing of the slats are adjusted accordingly to support the cartons as the above method. Additional sizing to the 1200mm X 1000mm there are pallets for different fruits and markets as follows:

- 1160mm x 1000mm – Black block pallets
- 1190mm x 990mm – Purple block pallets
- 1125mm x 960mm – Green block pallets
